I Sue McLoughlin was recently the recipient of an inheritance from my Mother, Marion Cruickshank, who passed away January 4th, 2014. The inheritance she left for her family was based on the sale of her home in Vancouver, B.C. It was her intent that the funds from the home would be divided 3 ways between her daughters. Their portions would then be divided in half, half for them to keep and the other half to be divided among their children. The amount Sue McLoughlin received was \$370000 and after division her daughter Stephanie Walker received 115,000\$ as part of the inheritance. This amount was promised after Marion Cruickshank's will was read in May of 2014. Thus the funds were expected since that day even though they were not received until the end of January 2015 based on the sale of the house in Vancouver.
