We will automatically calculate the goods and services tax/harmonized sales tax credit and any related provincial credit based on your family net income, province of residence, marital status, and qualified children. We will let you know in July if you are entitled to any credit for the period from **July 2015 to June 2016**.

We will deposit your refund into the account shown on your direct deposit application.

A Tax-Free Savings Account (TFSA) allows Canadian residents, who are 18 years of age or older, to earn tax-free investment income throughout their lifetime.
